What to bring: T-shirt & shorts (rashies/thermals if you have them), Sandals, thongs or water sport shoes (they will get wet!), Bottle of water (you will get thirsty), A change of clothes (your paddling clothes will get wet!), Plastic bag (to put your wet clothes in), Towel, Sun block, Hat
